General Information

What is the Jesuit Volunteer Corps Northwest Benefit Dinner?

The annual Benefit dinner is JVC Northwest's largest gathering and fundraiser of the year. We invite people in the JVC Northwest community, friends, family, and supporters of JVC Northwest to come together in person to celebrate the service of our volunteers, partner agencies, and raise critical funds for our future sustainability. The Benefit Dinner is designed to be a place where guests are invited and called to feel generous.

What are the expectations in my role as a Table Host for this event?

Be warm, be hospitable, be you! Table hosts are essential volunteers who help JVC Northwest by inviting people to attend and support JVC Northwest at our Benefit Dinner at Seattle University. We count on you to fill a table of eight: you plus seven guests. These can be friends, family members, church members, or co-workers. Think about if there is anyone who would be interested in getting to know JVC Northwest and our mission and wants to experience the community. Perhaps there is a young adult you know who may be interested in becoming a Jesuit Volunteer in the future. Since this is a fundraiser, invite people who will feel compelled to be generous.

Table Hosts are points of contact for guests and during the event are a bridge to further connect guests who may or may not know each other. And of course, enjoy the event yourself! Thank you for taking on this important and essential role!

General Information

What does it cost to attend?

Our Standard ticket price is \$95 per ticket, and a full Standard Table cost is \$760. Consider being a Core Supporter at the \$125 ticket level - each ticket at this level comes with one raffle ticket. A Core Supporter Table costs \$1,000.

Where do my guests register and purchase tickets?

This year, everyone will need to register. There are two options for registering:

- If guests are purchasing their own ticket, they will register as part of the purchasing process. [Click here for the link.](#)
- If you (the Table Host) are purchasing their ticket, then there will be a separate registration link for them to fill out. [Click here for the link.](#)

Both of these links will also be on [our website here](#). Registration is also where people can let us know of any accommodations they need met, like dietary restrictions.

Make sure as a Table Host that you communicate efficiently with your guests about registering.

What can guests look forward to at the event?

Be prepared to be in fellowship with the incredible JVC Northwest Community! There will be a plated dinner with non-vegan, vegan, and gluten-free options. Guests will be able to list dietary restrictions when they register. There will be many opportunities to lean into giving generously, where funds will go directly to supporting our volunteers and communities. Program Includes: Fr. Jack Morris, S.J. Memorial Award, Magis Award, reflections from current Jesuit Volunteer, a JV EnCorps Member and more! It will truly be a wonderful evening of celebrating the patchwork of stories that make up JVC Northwest, past, present, and future.

Step-by-Step Checklist - Before the Event

Make contact

If you have been a Table Host before, list your past years' guests first and then others you want to invite. This is a fundraising event that is crucial to funding our program, so we encourage inviting people who will feel compelled to be generous. Decide how to contact your guests; for example, will you make a phone call, a letter, an email, or will you see them in person? Connect with people through storytelling. How did you get involved with JVC Northwest and what inspires you? Then invite them to join you in supporting the organization.

Create some competition

Challenge your best friend or a previous table guest to step up to host and fill a table! Contact Kelly Hickman at khickman@jvcnorthwest.org to have a Table Host packet sent on your behalf.

Direct guests to register or purchase tickets online

The sooner your guests purchase tickets, the better. Tickets will go on sale January 31. Please encourage them to purchase their tickets and register by March 16: <https://jvcnorthwest.org/benefit>. Send them to the website and the FAQ section if they have any questions.

Encourage your guests to invite their friends

Ask, "Do you know someone who would value learning about JVC Northwest's mission?" The more the merrier!

Ask those who can't attend to donate online

Direct those who cannot make it to donate online at <https://jvcnorthwest.org/benefit> in lieu of attendance. All donations help us reach our goal of \$175,000! Each contribution is valued.

Invite someone to help you host

It's a great idea to have someone prepared to assist you at the event. They can help engage a new or nervous guest and welcome table guests if you must attend to last-minute needs

Communicate expectations

While this is a fun and social gathering, the main purpose of the event is a fundraiser for JVC Northwest. If you purchase your guests' tickets, suggest making a donation at ticket price. Make sure to be clear that this is a fundraiser; guests should not be surprised by requests for donations. Our goal is to raise \$175,000 this year.

Finalize guests

Encourage your guests to purchase their tickets online at <https://jvcnorthwest.org/benefit> by March 16. There will undoubtedly be changes in the week before the event but aim to have your table filled and your guests registered by that date.

Tables accommodate 8 people. To avoid having empty seats, we suggest that you recruit more than 8 guests – including yourself! We will seat any overflow guests at an adjacent table. If you have fewer than 8 guests (including yourself), we can add one to two independent guests to your table.

Keep reminding your guests

Even up until the morning of the event! We are counting on their participation! Communicate your plans with your guests so they know where to find you, how to meet up, if you are attending the optional mass, etc.

Step-by-Step Checklist - During the Event

Last minute cancellation?

Don't worry: simply let us know at check-in and we can often fill that empty seat. For changes, just email Kelly Hickman (khickman@jvcnorthwest.org).

Offer a warm touch

Do you want to personalize your table? Some table hosts include place cards, thank you notes, or treats like chocolates at their table.

Connect with everyone personally

Be sure to personally welcome your guests before the program gets going and direct them to your table. Are there people sitting together who don't know each other? Provide a warm introduction to ignite the conversation. Find similar interests, connections, etc.

Enjoy yourself!

Thank you so much for your efforts! We hope that you spend the evening connecting and re-connecting with those around you, enthusiastically supporting our mission, and celebrating our core values.

Step-by-Step Checklist - After the Event

Guests didn't show up?

Express your apologies that they could not attend the event, let them know what a success it was, share the stories you heard, and ask them to make a donation online.

Personally thank your guests

JVC Northwest will send thank you emails, but a personal thank you from you will be meaningful. Make thank you calls or send thank you notes in the week after the event.
